



## Pinwheel Row

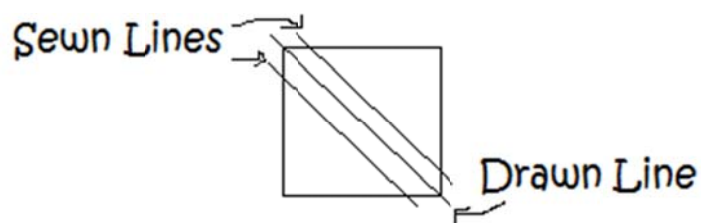

For this row you will be sewing 7 pinwheel blocks. For each pinwheel you will need 2 different colors + your background fabric.

Cut List: For EACH BLOCK you will need-

- ❖ 8 -- 2 ½ inch X 2 ½ inch background
- ❖ 2 -- 2 7/8 inch X 2 7/8 inch background
- ❖ 1 -- 2 7/8 inch X 2 7/8 inch color one
- ❖ 1 -- 2 7/8 inch X 2 7/8 inch color two
- ❖ 2 -- 2 ½ inch X 2 ½ inch color one
- ❖ 2 -- 2 ½ inch X 2 ½ inch color two

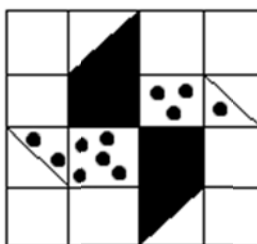
Step 1: Match up one background 2 7/8 square with color one 2 7/8 square. Right sides together. Draw a line from corner to corner and sew ¼ inch on BOTH sides of drawn line.



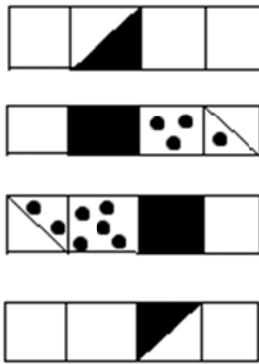
Step 2: Cut on DRAWN line. You will now have 2 – half square triangles. Iron to the dark side.

Step 3: Repeat step 1 and 2 with color two.

Step 4: Lay the pieces out to keep everything nice and organized.



Step 5: Sew the pieces together Row by Row.



Step 6: Sew the rows together.

Step 7: Repeat steps 1-6 for the other blocks. You will need 7 blocks all together.



Step 8: Sew all blocks together in a row. Don't worry about it being the same length as the other rows. We will work that out at the end.
